Did You Know...?

Since 1992, the City of Monroe's medical calls have tripled.
In 2000, Mayor Worrell made all the motions to start the Advanced Life Support Program.

In 2000, your Monroe Firefighters started an Advanced Life Support service to serve you better. Now your city council members and Mayor want to eliminate it.

85% of all emergency calls are medical based.

Every Monroe City Firefighter is also a Paramedic.

Your Fire Department was already cut 25% in 2008; Council wants to cut it 33% more in 2009. That's half of your Fire Department in ONE YEAR.

Our Fire Chief recommended to City council that he wants to close your East Side Fire Station.

East side residents could wait up to 10 minutes for their first fire truck.

Your Fire Department's average response time is 3-4 minutes; the proposed replacement ambulance has a response time average of 10-12 minutes urban and 15 minutes rurally.
